What Do You Love?

Best for ages 3-8. The goal of this game is to help children view mistakes as golden opportunities to learn for the future and become wiser.

If we do not learn from our mistakes, how will we ever grow?

Use the game as a catalyst for exploring the tendency to rationalize poor decisions, rather than learning and growing from them.

When we choose to rationalize rather than learn we are missing out on the chance to further develop and flourish.

Print out the memory game (available on the main Elul/Tishrei page with all of the downloads). You can either print it out on card stock (any print shop will have this in stock), print it out and glue it to light cardboard, or just use paper. Cut out all of the squares.

Each match depicts a situation where a person is actively making a mistake or about to make a mistake. When someone gets a match, have them verbalize the mistake on the cards and provide a constructive lesson that the person can learn for the future.
