World Window Decoration

Supplies Needed:

- Torah, Avodah and Gemilus Chasadim Foundations template
- Small pieces of blue and green tissue paper
- Wax paper
- Art supplies:
 - Glue
 - Mod podge
 - Paint brushes
 - Scissors
 - Single hole puncher
 - Ribbon
 - Permanent marker

Best for ages 3-8. This activity is a beautiful arts and crafts activity regarding the 3 pillars that the worlds stands on: Torah, Avodah and Gemilus Chasadim.

1. Print out the Torah, Avodah and Gemilus Chasadim Foundations template and copy it onto a piece of wax paper using a permanent marker. Color in the letters.

2. Once complete, give the wax paper to your child and have your child tear and crumple many pieces of green and blue tissue paper and glue them in the globe, covering the entire globe.

3. Once the globe is covered with tissue paper, mod podge another piece of wax paper on top of it.

4. Once dry, cut the wax paper to a nice square or round shape, hole punch the top and place a piece of ribbon through it to hang it from a window.



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
